Issue of Construction Consents Form 1 – documents to be submitted

Below is a synopsis of the required documents/information that must be submitted in support of an application for Construction Consent. Full details can be obtained in Section 2.6 of the Roads Development Guide. The developer/applicant/agent should utilise Form CC9 – Construction Consent checklist. Available on request, when applying for Construction Consent approval.

The following must be submitted, where required, to enable a Construction Consent application to be registered. Failure to provide this information will result in the application not being registered or assessed in detail:

- 1. The correct CC1 Form used and duly completed correctly.
- 2. The correct CC2 Form used and duly completed correctly (if required).
- 3. The correct CC3 Form used and duly completed correctly (if required).
- 4. The correct CC5 Form used and duly completed correctly (if required).
- 5. A location plan.
- 6. A layout plan.
- 7. A longitudinal section.
- 8. Typical cross sections.
- 9. All drawings docqueted, dated and signed.
- 10. A safety audit (where required).
- 11. A factual ground investigation report including interpretative report.
- 12. Street lighting drawings and design calculations.
- 13. Report from the Coal Authority/Mining Consultant.
- 14. Report from the British Geological Survey.
- 15. Structural design calculations (where required).

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
